



OPT-OUT OF BEING RECONTACTED FOR RESEARCH PARTICIPATION

GeneDx may collaborate with researchers to advance knowledge of genetic diseases and to develop new treatments. If there are opportunities to participate in research relevant to a person's test results or health condition, GeneDx may allow a person's healthcare provider to be recontacted for research purposes. Examples may include the development of certain types of new testing, drug development, or new treatments. In some situations, such as if a person's healthcare provider is not available, the person may be contacted directly.

Any research that results in medical advances, including new products, tests, or discoveries, may have potential commercial value and may be developed and owned by GeneDx or the collaborating researchers. If any individuals or corporations benefit financially from these studies, no compensation will be provided to those undergoing testing or their heirs.
